Communication Content

December 13, 2021

Information security is of utmost priority to Actian. A new vulnerability dated December 10, 2021, Oracle Corporation [Oracle Security Alert Advisory - CVE-2021-44228](#) identifies a vulnerability in Apache Log4j. It is remotely exploitable without authentication, i.e., may be exploited over a network without the need for a username and password. The exploitable versions of Apache Log4j are versions 2.0 - 2.14.1

Actian has have given this vulnerability a security threat level of "low" as it directly impacts our products.

Please be advised that Actian is doing an internal review of our software products and the vulnerability impacts of each product.

Actian Products that have no impact from this vulnerability, they do not use Log4j.

- Actian Enterprise Access
- Actian Zen
- Actian DataConnect Version 11 and prior versions
- Actian DataConnect DataCloud
- Actian OpenRoad

Actian Products that use Log4j but unaffected versions.

- Actian Avalanche
- Actian X
- Actian Ingres

- Actian VectorH
- Actian DataFlow
- Actian NoSQL

Actian Products that have been identified as impacted by this vulnerability and use Apache Log4j v2.0 or greater.

- Actian DataConnect Version 12 (only)

The core Actian DataConnect V12 functionality does not use Log4j. Data Profiler is an application within Actian DataConnect V12 and uses affected version Apache Log4j, v2.14.1

Actian DataConnect V12 was removed from our download site on December 13, 2021 and will be replaced by a patched version. Actian engineering is working on a patch release for v12 that will be available in the coming days. We recommend not using Data Profiler until the update is released to our download site.

Actian Engineering is still investigating Actian Director and Actian Management Server for Actian Vector and Actian Ingres. Actian will send out an update once we determine if they are impacted.
