Dear Valued Actian Customer,

Information security is of utmost priority to Actian. A PHP vulnerability [CVE-2016-4539](#) exists in the Actian EMA product 4.2.0 and all previous versions because they utilize this affected PHP version. No other Actian product contains this vulnerability.

Actian has have given this vulnerability a security threat level of "low". The attacker would need to have access to the EMA console to utilize this and the attack could cause a SIGSEGV which would bring down your EMA instance only.

Actian EMA 4.2.0 has been removed from our download site on January 14<sup>th</sup>, 2022 and was replaced by Actian EMA 4.2.1 which contains an updated PHP version that does not contain the vulnerability.
